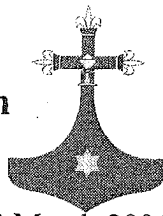

Dear Mr. Taiclet,

I write to you requesting your attention to a pending legal and negative public relations matter for American Tower, of which you may be unaware. Rather than permitting this situation to deteriorate further, I am appealing to your sense of fairness and good judgment.

I am the Prior of the Teresian Carmelites, a community of consecrated Brothers and Sisters in Worcester, Massachusetts. Steeped in the rich legacy of the Carmelite Order, we combine a life of eremitical living with contemplative observance and peaceful prayer.

In May 2005, my community signed a Purchase and Sale Agreement with American Tower Corporation for a 99-acre parcel of land located in Paxton, Massachusetts, where we plan to build a monastery. Our plans for the development of the property include an authentic “green” monastery—environmentally sound. We are working with Paxton and the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MTC) to erect windmills for the purpose of generating power that will, in part, subsidize low-income families—a ministry in service to the poor.

On the day we were to close on the property, October 31, 2005, at the request of your Senior Vice President, Ross Elder, we agreed to an amended closure date. With a bank check for \$225,000 in hand, Steven Brav of American Tower reneged on the signed Agreement and refused to close on the amended date, November 30, 2005. On several occasions since, Mr. Elder has contacted me, attempting to change the terms of the Agreement. Mr. Elder offered us a 99-year lease, which we rightfully refused.

Mr. Elder, apparently anticipating potential income for your company said, “I would look like a fool if I sold you the property”. He inferred that the property has greater value due to our studies and investigation into the feasibility of wind power on the site.

The refusal to honor your agreement is an unfair business practice that has caused us great hardship. It has forced us to hire legal counsel and to take American Tower to court to successfully obtain an injunction against American Tower precluding the sale or encumbrance of the property. We have recently file the necessary papers to obtain an order for specific performance of the Agreement. This is not a complicated case and your attorneys have presented no evidence to justify their refusal to execute said Agreement.

Enclosed please find a copy of the Purchase and Sale Agreement, a copy of the check to American Tower for the balance due, a copy of the court order granting the injunction, and our Motion for Summary Judgment and memorandum, etc., in support thereof.

I am confident that once you have reviewed the enclosed information, you will conclude that this situation is best resolved by executing said Agreement. If this matter is not rectified in a timely fashion, I am left with no other recourse but to present the facts of American Tower's unethical business practice to members of your board and/or the media. We are poised to be in contact with all forms of media, including print, internet, television and radio.


This sacred ground is the fulfillment of our quest. By virtue of initiating and, since October 28 2005, being willing and able to execute said Agreement, this *mountain of peace* is rightfully ours. We will take every legally available measure to insure that justice prevails. History has foretold the conclusion of this epic. We have God's resources to fight the good fight against our "Goliath" (American Tower).

A long-held aspiration of mine since 1978 is to find a piece of land of solace, sanctuary and simplicity. I have searched in earnest since 1982 for a property on which we could build a monastery. Finally, on a quiet mountain in a 'town of peace' I have found the land that God has called us to build upon.

Mr. Taiclet, I am appealing to you in good faith, and pray for an expedient resolution to this matter. Praised be Jesus Christ.

Blessings Ms. Almonte,

Your kindness and genteel disposition over the telephone was a blessing and calmed my nervousness in making this telephone call. As I stated in our conversation, I have begun to contact the media due to what I believe to be an injustice on the part of American Tower and Industrial Communication & Electronics.

After prayerful consideration of the matter at hand, as well as considering the amount of money lost to this litigation (*well over \$3,655,000 + — we have lost the opportunity for the MTC to place two wind turbines [\$3,500,000 per] on the property for the use of subsidizing electricity to low income families in Massachusetts.*), which I explained in our conversation. This does not include the work, time and resources of Joseph Ryan, Doug Aube (may he rest in peace), Steve Brav and Ross Elder, all employees of American Tower.

As a contemplative (monk), I have no desire to be in the media, but feel there is no other resource for me to peruse, that can bring to the light the practices that have prevented the execution of our signed Purchase & Sale agreement in November 2005, and now. This does include the interfering efforts of Mr. Dave Fenton of Industrial Communication & Electronics.

I pray, Ms. Almonte, that you bring my considerations before Mr. Taiclet, so that we may bring a win/win closure to this situation. Then I can focus all my attention to our life of prayer, and the beginning of our monastic building in Paxton.
